### Update: Implementation of New Consensus Policies Applicable to gTLD Registrars

21 September 2004

This announcement is an update concerning the implementation of four new "Consensus Policies" applicable to ICANN-accredited gTLD registrars: the new <u>Expired Domain Deletion Policy</u>, and the previously announced Inter-Registrar Transfer Policy, Whois Marketing Restriction Policy, and Restored Names Accuracy Policy.

#### Expired Domain Deletion Policy

Today ICANN announced the implementation of the Expired Domain Deletion Policy (EDDP). This consensus policy defines a uniform deletes practice that registrars must follow at the time of domain name expiry, as well as specific requirements for registrar handling of expired names that are subject to a UDRP dispute.

The EDDP was developed through ICANN's Generic Names Supporting Organization in response to concerns in the community about registrar
